	14.00	The National Archaeological Museum – Prehistoric collection (the Mycenaean world, burial rites, weapons, art), Sculpture collection (the female body in Greek art), Pottery collection (funeral rites on vases, white-ground lekythoi, Panathenaic amphorae, paintings from the Argive Heraion)
